Pool Rules 2016

1. All members and their families are responsible for registering themselves and their guests on arrival the pool area daily.
2. Guests must be accompanied by a member unless specific arrangements have been made with the General Manager or Pool Manager. Guests may not visit more than 4 times per season, regardless of how many members act as host.
3. Guest fees will be charged to member's accounts
 - a. Children \$5 Everyday
 - b. Adults \$7 weekdays and \$10 weekends
4. Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests.
5. Obey lifeguards and other supervisory personnel. Talking with lifeguard(s) on duty is prohibited.
6. Proper swim attire is required when swimming or sunbathing. No street clothes in the pool.
7. No diaper-clad babies are permitted in either pool. Swim diapers must be worn in both pools.
8. Showering before entering pools is recommended.
9. No running, pushing or throwing anyone into the pool.
10. No rough games, horse play, wrestling or other conduct affecting the safety of other swimmers is permitted.
11. Water toys are permitted in the pool area, however Pool Managers and Staff reserve the right to restrict any toy or float as needed to insure safety.
12. Children 10 and under must have a parent or guardian in the pool area.

13. Beginning swimmers may use the main pool only if approved by the pool managers. All children 10 and under must remain in the shallow end of the pool unless they have passed a swimming test.
14. No child under 5 years of age may be in the main pool unless accompanied by an adult.
15. Stay off the rope which divides the deep-water area from the shallow area.
16. No glassware of any kind is allowed past the main entrance to the pool area. The use of plastic containers for lotions, drinks, baby bottles, etc is recommended.
17. Members are not permitted to bring their own food or beverage to the pool at any time.
18. No food or beverages are allowed in the locker rooms.
19. Adults have priority over children with regard to chairs and chaise lounges.
20. No one is permitted to sit or play on or climb over any fence or stone wall into the pool area.
21. Be alert to help anyone in trouble. Call for help immediately. Do not move or remove injured people from the water who complain of back or neck pain.
22. Two long whistle blasts means to clear the pool! Clear pools immediately when sounded and follow instructions.

Baby Pool

1. Each child in the wading pool and wading pool area **MUST** be directly supervised by the parent or a baby sitter who is fully responsible for the child. **NOTE: THE WADING POOL IS NOT UNDER THE CONSTANT SUPERVISION BY A GUARD.**
2. No children over the age of six are permitted in the wading pool.
3. Water toys are permitted in the wading pool, the Pool Manager and Staff reserves the right to restrict any toy which in his judgment may provoke a problem involving safety or convenience to other swimmers.
4. All pool rules apply to the baby pool.
5. Approved Swim Diapers must be worn at all times while in the baby pool – and swim suits are required.
